The course will visit some of the best Irish examples of developing irregular stands and will focus on the key steps that lead to transformation. The pathways between the Stages of transformation, 1. Preparation, 2. Initiation of regeneration, 3. Structural development and 4. Structural attainment will be elaborated with the assistance whenever possible of real forest conditions.

Topics to include:

- Forest planning & infrastructure
- Forest inventory & tree marking
- Harvesting systems & operations
- How to maximize added-value
